Weiner Team Top Op-Eds Big Beautiful Bill, Mamdani, Birth Rates, Nuclear Freeze, Federal Cuts, Anti-Western Alliance, Claude Pepper, More & TV-Radio

**WASHINGTON, D.C.** — Over the past two months, Robert Weiner and co-writers from RWA and the Solutions for Change Foundation have had op-eds featured prominently across national media. Their commentaries have appeared in leading publications, including The PuLSE Institute, International Policy Digest, Daily Hampshire Gazette, Orlando Sentinel, Missouri Independent, and OpEd News, where multiple pieces ranked H1, H2, H4, and H5 among the nation's top op-eds. In addition, Weiner has provided live studio analysis on major broadcast outlets such as GB News TV-Radio (UK) and Talk TV, as well as Main Street Radio in U.S., offering insights on U.S. politics, foreign policy, healthcare, and global security.

The Weiner group has written on issues ranging from poverty and Social Security to housing affordability, international alliances, reproductive policy, nuclear arms, fact-checking in journalism, federal health research cuts, and NASA funding. Their work has addressed both domestic and global challenges, arguing for fairness, accountability, and bipartisan solutions.
